

Eternal QA

- National QAA;
- National Committee;

Procedure EQA:

_preparation of the report, HEI review, meetings, publication of the decision Independent agency assurance system

Careful study of standards;

Squatted test results



Basic principles of expertise

- Passing an independent QA in the country;
- ► MANDATORY EXAMINATION (OBTAINED BY OWN INITIATIVE)
- SELF-EVALUATION
- The European Registry Committee is responsible for initiating the accreditation



QAA: UK Experience

- QAA (Quality Assurance Agency) is an independent charitable organization
 funding from university fees / specialist contracts, institutions;
- Composition 125 persons and 550 reviewers;
- Peer review the evaluation of the elements is carried out by experts of the same level from other HEI, for example: assessment of teaching teachers of other HEIs, assessment of administration - representatives of administration of other HEI;
- Since 2009, students can be included in the expert group
- Mandatory open reporting of the results of the evaluations conducted on the organization's website.



EQAR

- **EQAR** created in 2008 (19 countries), in 2013 32 countries
- open to all agencies
- Displays the compliance of quality assurance agencies with European standards
- Provides reliable information about registered agencies
- ▶ The decision to register is the Committee on European Register Affairs
- (ENQA performs a secretary function in the Committee)
- ENQA + EQAR = development of cooperation in the field of quality assurance in higher education






